Chiquis

Chiquis is a two-time Latin GRAMMY-winning recording artist (singer and songwriter), businesswoman, author and television celebrity. Chiquis is recording new music following her recent Latin GRAMMY win for "Abeja Reina" and is also recording season two of her English language podcast on iHeart Radio "Chiquis and Chill," which reached No. 5 in the Spotify Top Podcast Chart in the USA. Chiquis began her solo singing career in 2013, and less than two years later, her first album Ahora became No. 1 in sales for two consecutive weeks on iTunes with the album's five singles ranking in the top 10 on national radio stations. Currently, Chiquis is promoting her album "Abeja Reina" released May 2022 with singles including "Mi Problema", "Abeja Reina" and "Porque Soy Abeja Reina." In addition to her GRAMMY wins, the young singer has won a Premio Lo Nuestro for Female Artist of the Year (2017) and Female Artist of the Year, Regional Mexican (2016) as well as a Premio de la Radio for Female Artist of the Year (2015).

George Thorogood and the Destroyers - Bad All Over the World Tour: 50 Years of Rock

George Thorogood is an American blues rock vocalist/guitarist who garnered worldwide fame with his hit song "Bad to the Bone" as well as for reverently reinventing obscure blues, country and R&B tracks by icons that include Bo Diddley, John Lee Hooker and Hank Williams via now-classic hits like "Who Do You Love?," "Boogie Chillun" and "Move It On Over," keeping the music of these American Masters alive for the MTV generation and beyond.

Julian Torres was born in Hawthorne, California to Mexican parents who instilled a great love for Mexico's music and traditions since he was in the womb. As a child, he was inspired to become a mariachi musician and began his career singing in community events and church carnivals. He has traveled and performed in many prestigious venues both in the US and abroad; across many stages including Disney's Merriest Nites, Dodger Stadium, Sábado Gigante, Carnegie Hall, the Hollywood Bowl, Teatro Metropolitan CDMX; and for our military troops overseas in Okinawa, Japan. His first EP, Epoca de Oro is a wildly popular tribute to his roots and mariachi heritage.

Dustin Lynch has built one of the most consistent recording careers in modern country music, achieving eight No. 1 hits, four Top 5 albums, 10 Gold and Platinum-certified singles, and tallying over four billion global on-demand streams. Recently releasing slow burner "Wood On The Fire" and wrapping the expanded Party Mode Tour, Lynch's fifth studio album, "Blue in the Sky," features Platinum six-week No. 1 song "Thinking 'Bout You (feat.
